牧者心聲

這是上帝向你說的話:

「你臨深淵,我和你在一起; 你渡江河,河水不淹沒你。 你踏炭火,不被灼傷; 你陷在火袋裏,不受傷害。」(賽 43:2.現中)

二零二零年對於全世界來說都是艱辛的日子,我們基督徒呢?也不能倖免。但是,我們有上帝上述的應許,無論經歷大水,燙過烈燄,也不受傷害。上帝不是空口講白話,以色列民族渡過紅海與約旦河而得應許之地。但以理三位朋友在紅紅烈火的爐中行走,見證上帝大能的保護而不被灼傷。上帝的話千古不變,因為祂就是祂說話的背書,上帝是昔在,今在,永在的神,祂的應許既在昨天成就,也會在今天發生,更不用懷疑明天都會兑現。無論你在二零二零年經歷大水或烈火,要記住上帝在以賽亞書的這個應許,你就是這個應許的見證人。教會更是,甚麼是教會?教會就是你,教會就是我,教會是否有力量,是視乎我們是否從上帝所領受的,藉著聖靈的能力,活出基督耶穌的樣式,在我們這一代見證三一神的應許,祂的應許千真萬確的成就在這些日子中。

Pastor's Reflection

This is what God said to you:

"When you pass through the waters,

I will be with you;

And when you pass through the rivers,

They will not sweep over you.

When you walk through the fire,

You will not be burned;

The frames will not set you ablaze." (Isaiah 43:2 NIV)

The 2020 year was a difficult time for the world. How did we Christians do? We were not spared either but we have the promise of God as said in the passage above. Regardless of experiencing big storm or intense fire and flames, we are not harmed. God does not speak with empty words as shown in the bible, and He let the people of Israel cross the Red Sea and Jordan River to get to the promised land. Daniel's three friends, walked in the raging fire of a furnace, witnessed the mighty of God's protection and did not get burned. The Word of God will never change because He is the endorsement of what He has spoken, Who is and Who was and the everlasting God. His promises were fulfilled in the past and continue to happen today, and no doubt will be honoured tomorrow. Regardless of whether you have experienced a big storm or intense fire in 2020, remember God's promise in Isaiah; you are the witness of this promise, and also the Church. What is the Church? In 2020 our church had originally planned a lot of evangelism, discipleship training and ministry, with arrangements made for the in time, place, speakers and the behind-the-scene planning, as well as cooperation with other churches and Gospel organizations. However, unexpectedly, Covid-19 swept right through the world. It really taught us, and the whole world, a good lesson: that we should come before God humbly. Jacob reminded us not to boast about tomorrow and what we will do tomorrow. He said, "Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes.

15 Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." (James 4:14-15 NIV)". We mistakenly think that we will have tomorrow, we mistakenly think that tomorrow's situation will be based on our expectations, and we mistakenly think that what we planned will be fulfilled, but we did not humbly come before God and seek for His will. What is God's will? Has He concurred with our plan? Is He pleased?

In 2020 our ministry work definitely shrank compared to previous years, but we still want to thank God the Father. The ministry seems to have slowed down, and Sunday worship, Sunday School, prayer meetings, fellowships and cell groups were subject to obstacles. However, I saw brothers' and sisters' spiritual lives make progress because we all cherished the moments of being together. We learned to use electronic devices in virtual meetings, and gradually regained lost ground. Sunday worship, Sunday School, prayer meetings, fellowships, cell groups and all other meetings were held as usual. We really appreciate the efforts of the Church Reopening Team, and the brothers who made the streaming network available for services to be restored gradually. Some virtual gatherings were even more active in the number of attendees compared to the previous



physical meetings. Even the senior brothers and sisters have also learned to use electronic devices. They are excited to see each other on-line, and fellowship together, encourage each other, and pray for each other. That's right. Life requires lifelong learning and experiencing the wonders of God together. In particular, I rescheduled the Sunday School (originally for Bible study on Sunday) to Tuesday night, so that brothers and sisters will not only have the Word of God in Sunday worship but also have the words from the Bible during the whole week: Bible study and prayer meetings on Sunday (Mandarin), Wednesday (English) and Thursday (Cantonese). As such, God's Word continues to teach and serves as reminders throughout the whole week. Since all meetings were conducted online, we have attracted some people to join us who we were not able to contact in the past. We are actually surprisingly pleased. Thanks to our Heavenly Father. Hopefully we will be spiritually closer to one another and be built up together. Although the pandemic is very severe, our hearts are fiery together in Christ and we desire His words so much. Although Covid-19 causes separation among people, it cannot separate brothers and sisters in the Lord's loving friendship. Although the pandemic makes us stay at home in isolation, it cannot stop our brothers and sisters in caring for each other. I really want to thank our Heavenly Father for all our MCPC brothers and sisters.

In terms of ministry, with thanks to the Father, He called His servant Adrian Lo to be a full-time pastor for our Children and Youth Ministry in May. Even in this pandemic, God continues to lead us to expand the reach of the gospel so that the future generations will be taken care of. God bless our Church and His servants. God is the God of call. In August, He moved our part-time Mandarin Pastor Tang Kai Yiu and let him return to Hong Kong to continue his ministry. Hopefully God's will is achieved. No matter where, we all are serving the same Lord. God's deed is actually beautiful. We had Elders ordained in October. We were really pleased and want to offer our praise and thank God for the newly elected Elder Philip Lee, Liu Huang Hsiu Chen and Ambrose Lo. It is really precious for the Elders to shoulder their burdens in these difficult days. No matter what comes in the future, we hope that MCPC will thrive in the unity of the gospel of Jesus Christ, so that many more people will come to the Lord and glorify God.

No matter what happens on earth, no matter what happens to the religious denomination, no matter what happens to the church, no matter what happens to your family or yourself, do not forget the trust God has given us!

English Pastor's Reflection.

Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." James 4:13-15

If ever a year showed the wisdom of the warning "you do not even know what will happen tomorrow," 2020 did. Plans great and small were washed away in the changing circumstances of the COVID era. It would be easy to list things we were counting on and looking forward to that disappeared.

Amid all the things that changed, though, the most important thing stayed the same: "Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail." **Lamentations 3:22 (NIV).** A virus too small to see caused such great disruption in so many lives, but something else we couldn't see was a source of comfort and assurance. "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty... You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. **Psalm 91:1, 5-6 (NIV)**

In mid-March, we had to stop in-person worship services. We were forced out of routines we had developed over years which meant we had to learn how to do things differently. The move to online worship called for a different set of gifts than we were used to before. It was encouraging as people across MCPC worked together to find our way in the new setting.

It was an adjustment to get used to on-line fellowship meetings through Zoom, but we have learned and adapted. Our fellowships continue to stay in touch, a precious contact in these days of social distancing. We distributed Christmas gift bags and gathered people for an online Christmas fellowship. People old and young from the English Ministry gathered to share Christmas memories. It worked well, and we'll look for ways to do this again in the future.

Mission continues to be an important part of the English ministry. As people faced increased challenges because of the COVID-related dislocations, mission partners we supported were able to make Christ's care real in those needs. For example, we continued our support for the Markham Stouffville Crisis Pregnancy Centre, and they were able to help hundreds of families through these difficult days. We continued our support for international missions through Hands in Missions and Literacy and Evangelism Canada.

Over my years in ministry, I've written many annual reflections. They've usually been celebrations of the "big moments" in church life. This year, we didn't have a lot of "big moments," but we did have ongoing fellowships, Bible studies, prayer meetings, and conversations. This year, particularly, I'm remembering how often someone was there to share some caring act or word at just the right time when someone else needed it. "A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in a setting of silver." **Proverbs 25:11 (ESV)**

It has been encouraging to see how people responded creatively to the challenges of this uncertain year. With the restrictions this year, there are lots of things we couldn't do. It has been a joy to see people look at what we can do.



As for 2021? Last year I wrote, "Growing in service through mission, growing in praise through worship, growing in love through fellowship, growing in knowledge through teaching and learning; these have been the pillars of the English ministry over the years, and we pray they will continue to be the building blocks of faithfulness in the years to come." Lots of things may have changed this year, but these basic commitments remain solid.

As for our plans for 2021? As James wrote, "you ought to say, 'If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." **James 4:15** (**NIV**). We pray for wisdom to take advantage of opportunities the Lord gives us to grow in mission, worship, fellowship, and the knowledge of Jesus Christ. We pray that we would continue to build faithfully on the one foundation, Jesus Christ.

堂會報告

當我回顧 2020 年發生的事情時,這段經文浮現在腦海中「又如鷹攪動巢窩,在離鷹以上兩翅搧展,接取雛鷹,背在兩翼之上。」(申命記 32:11) 我們今年的生活肯定被「攪動」。我們每人或多或少也受到 COVID-19 新冠疫情的影響,這疫情於年初毫無警告地降臨在我們中間,沒有人能預測這疫情會變得如此廣泛和持久。

在過去的 31 年中,麥恆長老會也經歷許多變更,但是沒有一件事能比今次的影響更大。然而,我們需要學習的是要超越當前的困局,抓着上帝的旨意和應許。在 2020 年,我們還有很多值得感恩和紀念的時刻。

上帝攪動了巢穴,並準備在我們跌倒時拯救我們

新冠疫情在三月左右感染多倫多地區,我們不得不暫停實體崇拜。經過弟兄姊妹努力工作,我們很快開始在 YouTube 上直播主日崇拜。後來,我們還提供了電話直播,供給沒有互聯網的弟兄姊妹可以聆聽崇拜的進行。所有實體交往和活動都被暫停,我們轉而使用網上「交流」,包括會議,主日學,團契等等。上帝除去我們舒適的環境,是希望我們學會應對新的狀況。儘管我們在八月到十二月之間增添健康預防措施和加強清潔來支持實體崇拜,但出席人數有限。鑑於近日新冠疫情轉趨嚴峻,我們不得不在十二月再次暫停實體崇拜。

上帝應許了一位兒童與青年傳道人-羅傲鳴傳道(五月)

年初,堂會批准了聘請全職兒童與青年傳道人。經過四個月的尋找聘牧,聘牧委員會推薦了 羅傲鳴先生,我們都為神的呼召感到非常興奮。羅傲鳴先生曾在麥恆長老會擔任過各種職務, 是一個非常合適的人選。羅傲鳴傳道帶來新的和令人興奮的理念去服侍兒童和青少年,並增 強了牧師團隊。

上帝呼召鄧啓耀牧師回香港事奉 (八月)

麥恆長老會國語堂鄧牧師事奉近兩年後,被上帝呼召回港事奉。國語堂於8月23日舉行了特别的告别感恩崇拜,以感謝鄧牧師在麥恆長老會的時間。鄧牧師在國語堂崇拜方面帶來了不少更新,並在此期間專注於門徒訓練。堂會已經成立了聘牧委員會,正在尋找新的牧者,求神帶領。

上帝呼籲更多的弟兄姊妹參加堂會事奉 (9月和10月)

新冠疫情並沒有阻止上帝呼召更多的弟兄姊妹參加堂會事奉。我們按照已往時間表進行長老提名,探訪,甄選和會眾選舉,最後進行就職禮及按立。我們讚美上帝呼召新任的長老李宇鴻弟兄,劉黃秀珍姊妹,羅傲然弟兄擔任 2020-2026 年任期的堂會長老,而高恆志長老則再度獲選連任六年。儘管沒有召開實體特別教友大會去回應上帝的呼召,但卻有創紀錄的投票參予人數。

上帝賜給梅勤傑長老休息不再擔任堂會長老(10月)

堂會接受了梅勤傑長老的要求,在10月任期屆滿後不再繼續擔任堂會長老。梅長老於1990 年從香港移民加拿大後加入麥恆長老會。他在1992年被按立為麥恆長老會長老。梅長老曾 在許多不同委員會和團契擔任過職務,最近又在敬拜委員會,傳道委員會中擔任過職務,並 擔任合唱團顧問,粵語主日學校總監,基誼團契顧問以及粵語堂事工小組成員。堂會和麥恆 長老會感謝梅長老多年來的忠心事奉。



上帝教導我們要忠於祂的教導

麥恆長老會繼續對加拿大長老總會可能改變有關性和婚姻定義的教導和政策表示關切和不滿。 堂會繼續就此事舉行了無數次商討,又與其他志同道合的教會同工,討論了可能的結果和日 後的步驟。由於新冠疫情,2020年全國大會被取消,因此未對此事進行討論和表決。堂會 一致認為,這更改並不反映聖經的教導,因此不能接受婚姻不是一男一女的定義。為了表達 我們對在政策可能被更改的不滿,我們的會眾投票決定不奉獻給長老會支持宣教組織 (Presbyterians Sharing)。堂會已同意直接向其中一些機構提供財務支持,繞過長老總會。

上帝呼召我們跟隨他並繼續前進

儘管長老總會關於性的教義未明朗,上帝卻告訴麥恆長老會的領袖,要繼續為未來設定計劃和做好準備。堂會在2020年成立了兩個工作小組:遠景工作小組和向前望工作小組。第一小組的目的是在神給了堂會的恩賜和機會的幫助下重新聚焦我們的遠景。第二個小組則關注如果加拿大的長老總會改變其政策可能需要採取的立即行動及步驟。該小組還與其他會眾一起工作,並探討了可能代替的方案。

最後,讓我們以另一個提到鷹的經文互相鼓勵,提醒我們對上帝的盼望並相信他的信實。

但那等候耶和華的必從新得力。 他們必如鷹展翅上騰;他們奔跑卻不困倦,行走卻不疲乏。 以審亞書 40:31



Session

Elder Brian Lee

When I look back at what has happened in 2020, this Bible verse came to mind "like an eagle that stirs up its nest and hovers over its young, that spreads its wings to catch them and carries them aloft." (Deuteronomy 32:11). Our lives have definitely been "stirred". No one is not affected by the COVID-19 pandemic which descended upon us at the beginning of the year without any warning. No one could have predicted how widespread and long lasting this virus came to be.

MCPC has weathered many changes over the last 31 years, but none has shaken us as much to our core. Yet, it is important to see beyond our current circumstances and be confident in God's purpose and promises in these unprecedented times. We have much to celebrate and remember in 2020.

God stirred up the nest and was ready to catch us if we fall

The pandemic hit the Toronto area around March. We had to suspend in-person worship. Through the hard work of brothers and sisters, we quickly started livestreaming our worship on YouTube. Later, we also provided phone streaming to listen to the worship for those who do not have internet. All in-person meetings and activities were suspended. We switched to virtual meetings for various ministries including meetings, Sunday School, fellowships, etc. God shook us out of our comfort zone but watched over us and protected us during this time. Although we resumed in-person worship between August and December with health precautions and enhanced cleaning, the attendance was limited. In December, we had to suspend in-person service due to the increase in COVID-19 cases.

God promised a Children & Youth Pastor – Pastor Adrian Lo (May)

At the beginning of the year, Session approved the search for a Full-Time Children & Youth Pastor. After working through our Interim Moderator, Rev. Peter Ma of St. Andrews Markham Presbyterian Church, the search committee recommended Mr. Adrian Lo. We were all very excited that God called Pastor Adrian who has served in various capacities at MCPC. Pastor Adrian brought new and exciting ideas to serve the children and youth of MCPC and added to the pastoral staff complement.

God called Pastor Kai to serve in Hong Kong (August)

After servicing as a part-time Mandarin pastor for nearly two years, Pastor Kai was called by God to serve in Hong Kong. The Mandarin ministry held a special farewell worship August 23 to celebrate Pastor Kai's time at MCPC. Pastor Kai has brought many good changes to the Mandarin worship and has focused on discipleship during his time here. Session has formed a search committee and a search for a new pastor is underway.

God called more Elders to Serve (September & October)

The pandemic did not stop God calling more elders to serve in session. We followed our regular timetable for elder nomination, interviews, screening and congregation election, and finally induction and ordination. We praised God for calling new elders Philip Lee, Jennie Hsiu Chen Liu and Ambrose Lo to serve on session for the 2020-2026 term, and also for Elder Sam Ko to serve



another 6-year term. Despite no physical meeting for the special congregation meeting to confirm God's call, we had a record high number of members voting for the elder candidates.

God gave Elder K.K. Mui rest from servicing as a Session Elder (October)

Session accepted Elder Kan Kit Mui's request not to continue as a Session elder upon the expiration of his term in October. Elder K.K. as he is often known, joined MCPC in 1990 when he emigrated to Canada from Hong Kong. He was ordained as an Elder in MCPC in 1992. Elder K.K. has served in many committees and fellowships and more recently in the Worship Committee, Evangelism Committee, and as an Advisor to the Choir, Cantonese Sunday School Superintendent, Counsellor of Fellowship-in-Christ, and a member of the Cantonese Ministry Team. Session and MCPC thank Elder K.K. for his faithful service over the years.

God taught us to stay true to His teaching

MCPC continues to express concern and dismay that the Presbyterian Church in Canada may change its teaching and policy on sexuality and the definition of marriage. Session continued to hold numerous meetings on this matter, worked with other like-minded congregations, and talked about possible outcome and next steps. Due to the pandemic, the 2020 General Assembly was cancelled, and therefore this matter was not discussed and voted on. Session is unanimous that this change does not reflect the teaching of the Bible and therefore cannot accept an alternative definition of marriage. In order to express our views on the potential change in policy, our congregation has voted not to contribute to Presbyterians Sharing which supports a number of mission organizations and ministries both locally and internationally. Instead, Session has agreed to provide directly financial support to some of these agencies and bypass the national church.

God called us to follow Him and continue moving forward

Despite the uncertainty with the Presbyterian Church's teaching on sexuality, God told the leadership in MCPC to continue to plan and prepare for the future. In 2020, Session formed two working groups: the Vision Working Group and the Looking Forward Working Group. The purpose of the first group is to refocus our vision going forward given the gifts and opportunities that God has provided to MCPC. The second working group is more focus on the immediate steps that may be required if the Presbyterian Church in Canada changes its policy. This group also worked with other congregations and to explored alternatives that may be opened to MCPC.

In closing, let us encourage each other with another Bible verse which references eagles, to remind us of the hope in God and to trust in His faithfulness.

2020年是一個充滿挑戰的一年。教會各部門的運作都受到新冠病毒疫情的影響。

因感到疫情開始在社區擴散,我們在二月份作了一次清潔運動,將禮堂、課室、副堂及走廊消毒。更預早增購清潔消毒用品及預防物資以作準備。

三月中,省政府因新冠病毒疫情頒佈的緊急狀態令,安省進入停擺。教會實體崇拜和團 契聚會亦因而停止,崇拜只可以用線上舉行。

執事會在四月份初終於成功地將主日崇拜改在線上直播,其餘各部門的事工亦改用互聯網聚會。教會更加添了洗手液、消毒水、手套和預防面罩供工作人員使用。更備有幾種奉獻方式在疫期中供會友選擇。

雖然教會的實體聚會大都因疫情而取消,教會的物業管理和維修仍然繼續。我們幾位弟兄姊妹在一期副堂把舊物清理,移空一些位置,作為改建了一個辦公室給新聘的青少年牧者之用。二期入口的屋頂漏水亦已修復完畢。

新的電話系統 VoIP 終於安裝妥當,新系統比原來的電話月費節省許多。

八月下旬,由於政府放寬疫情指引的限制,教會因而重啓有限度的實體崇拜。招待組亦 作特别訓練接待和清潔的程序,務要確保弟兄姊妹在安全清潔的環境下崇拜。因疫情轉差, 實體崇拜在十二月份再次暫停。

受疫情影響,今年整體的收入相比年初的財政預算大幅減少。但在財政部很小心的處理 開支和申請政府各項支援計劃的努力之下,結果今年的年結仍有少許盈餘。

由於今年有很多不明朗的因素,確實是一個很難掌控的一年。執事們都在各崗位上不斷 努力,這是一個美好的見証。願榮耀歸與天上的父!



Board of Managers

The year 2020 was unexpectedly a very challenging year. The CoVid-19 pandemic has impacted the day- to- day operations of the church ministry.

A campaign was launched in February to disinfect and sanitize areas with high usage such as sanctuary, chapel and classrooms. Protective equipment and material were also prepared in anticipation of pandemic spreading.

In mid-March, the church was in a lockdown in response to the Ontario Government emergency regulation to the CoVid-19 pandemic. Decision was made having all Sunday Services only in live streaming.

In April, BOM managed successfully to link with a web site for live streaming worship service. Other essential ministries were also in virtual meetings. Sanitizing fluid and protective equipment were available for those who have reasons to work in the church. Various options were offered to the Congregation for donation during the lockdown period.

Although ministerial activities slowed down or suspended, Facility team continued to perform maintenance and essential repair work, including Phase 2 lobby water leaks in the roof. Phase 1 fellowship hall redundant items were disposed to free up space and modification was made to build an office for the newly hired Youth and Children worker.

New VoIP phone system was finally installed replacing the original land line, resulted a substantial saving to the monthly phone charges for the church.

In late-August, in-person worships were re-opened with restrictions in accordance to the Government guidelines. Stewardship team provided the sanitizing and ushering supports until another lockdown in December.

The revenue was reduced significantly from the planned budget due to impact from CoVid-19 pandemic. The treasurer team had monitored and controlled the church finances very closely during this hardship period. Despite the gaps with the budget plan, the overall year-end financial performance closed without deficit with the help from the Government Emergency Response Benefit program.

This year was exceptionally difficult to manage due to other unexpected issues. The Board members stand firm in carry out their assigned responsibilities. This is a true testimonial of rejoice in serving our Lord. May the glories and praises be with our God always.

差傳事工

我們既然從上帝那裡得到蒙召,行事為人就當與蒙召的恩相稱。凡事謙虛、溫柔、忍耐,用愛心互相寬容。我們被呼召不僅是在個人層面,而且更是要在社區當中,與各種文化,種族或國籍的人士分享耶穌的故事,以及見證耶穌如何道成了內身,住在我們中間。福音的使命是要提醒人們,上帝有多麼的愛我們,耶穌為我們的罪死在十字架上,使我們既然在罪上死,就得以在義上活,上帝永生的應許,對我們信耶穌的人變得有意義。

在二零二零年,我們將原本提供給加拿大長老會總會,任由他們去分配的宣教奉獻,改由我們自己選擇支持的宣教機構。我們聯絡及認識了以下十個差傳事工,以禱告並在財政上支持他們。當中的宣教機構有加拿大市內社區的、原住民、新移民、難民、城市及偏遠地區的事工,包括安大略省石溪鎮的綠色文化家庭教會,魁北克省滿地可西區長老會,多倫多士嘉堡的基督生命事工,安大略省巴黎長老會的紅蘿蔔事工,非洲馬拉威監獄事工,紐賓士域省北部事工,卑詩省威廉斯萊克的卡里布長老會,緬省溫尼伯阿拉伯福音燈塔教會事工,卑詩省溫哥華島香柏樹事工,與及魁北克省滿地可西洛克雷蒂安社區教會。

差傳部繼續支持本地和海外的差傳工作,向尋求讀神學進修的會友提供財政資助,又為我們的社區作出貢獻,例如捐助萬錦食物銀行和萬錦危機懷孕中心,提供人類的基本需要。我們與本地和國際宣教機構及組織合作,支持短期宣教和長期宣教的前線宣教士,Bill 及Elveera Redwood,林建嘉及林胡友好,麥裕沛,莊保羅師母等人到各個地方執行福音使命。感謝神的保守讓他們克服了冠狀病毒疾病的大流行。

但是由於疾病大流行,安大略省政府在三月中旬宣布進入緊急狀態後,我們取消了原本計劃在四月與多倫多士嘉堡的另一教會合作的耶穌受難話劇,以及於六月與香港敬拜音樂事工舉行的福音佈道聚會,會議被推遲到下一年或直到疾病大流行結束。因此今年餘下的時間我們也無法計劃任何事情,無法到我們的社區拍門探訪,分發福音小册子,邀請他們參加我們教會的活動,如感恩節午餐的類似活動也被取消。但是我們能夠在聖誕節期間,與多倫多基督徒短期宣教訓練中心及其他教會合作,舉行聖誕報佳音視像電話佈道活動,以聯絡我們未信主耶穌基督的親朋好友。

讓我們繼續分享福音,見證主基督,並爲福音工作做好準備,攜手合作,分享更多耶 穌的救贖故事,而主耶穌必帶給我們悔改並信靠救主基督的人,無論我們是撒種,或者是收 割,我們都謙卑地分享信仰和傳播福音。



Mission

The Call that we have received from God is to live a godly life worthy of His mercy and love, to be completely humble and gentle; to be patient, bearing with one another in love. We are called to do this not only on a personal level, but also as communities, to witness to people of every culture, ethnicity, and nationality by sharing the story of Jesus, and how He became flesh and made His dwelling among us. Gospel mission is to remind people how much God loves us, and that Jesus died on the cross for our sins so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness. The promise of eternal life with God becomes meaningful through faith to those who believe in Jesus.

In 2020, we chose our own list of mission projects instead of letting our national church, the Presbyterian Church of Canada (PCC), distribute our contribution in the Presbyterian Sharing fund to support their national mission programs and ministries. We came to know the following ten projects, we prayed for them and supported them financially. This list includes inner city, native, new immigrant, refugee, urban and remote ministries in Canada and international partners:

- Family Church of Heritage Green, Stoney Creek, Ontario;
- Montreal West Presbyterian Church, Montreal, Quebec;
- Life in Christ Ministries, Scarborough, Ontario;
- The Raw Carrot at Paris Presbyterian, Paris, Ontario;
- Prison Ministry, Malawi, Africa;
- Northern New Brunswick Ministry, New Brunswick;
- Cariboo House Church Ministry, Williams Lake, British Columbia;
- Lighthouse Evangelical Arabic Church, Winnipeg, Manitoba;
- Cedar Tree Ministry, Vancouver Island, British Columbia
- La Communitae Chretien Siloe, Montreal, Quebec.

The Mission Department also continues to support missionaries and para-church organizations with their local and overseas mission works, to provide financial assistance to our members pursuing theological studies, and also to contribute to our community through community organizations such as Markham Food Bank and the Markham-Stouffville Crisis Pregnancy Centre by providing basic necessities. We work with local and international mission agencies, sending and supporting short-term and long-term frontline missionaries Bill and Elveera Redwood, Linda and James Ling, Rudolf Mak, Carey Jo Johnston, and others fulfilling our Gospel missions as thankfully they overcame the coronavirus pandemic in their missions work.

Unfortunately, due to the pandemic, our planned Good Friday drama in partnership with another local church in Scarborough in April and an Evangelistic Meeting with a worship music ministry from Hong Kong in June were both cancelled once the Ontario government declared a state of emergency in mid-March. The meetings were postponed to the following year or until the pandemic is over. For the rest of the year, we could not visit our neighbourhood to distribute gospel tracts and invite our neighbours to join activities at our church since events like the Thanksgiving Luncheon was cancelled. However, we were able to work with the Toronto Chinese Christian Short Term Mission Training Centre and other churches for Telephone Evangelism at Christmas time to reach our unchurched friends and relatives.

We will continue to partner together faithfully by sharing the Gospel as we witness for Christ and equip ourselves and others for the work of evangelism. We hope that more salvation stories of leading someone to Jesus will be shared and the Lord will bring us people who repent and trust in Jesus Christ the Saviour. Whether we are sowing or harvesting, we will humbly share the gospel and our faith respectfully.



Children and Youth Ministry (CYM)

For the children's ministry, we transitioned to Zoom for online children worship. For the first three Sundays of each month, the children gather in the morning at 10:15am for worship where they take part in Bible story time, response, praying, feasting, and show and tell time. We're having a blast so far! And it is so encouraging to see our children interacting with one another and sharing life together again. I just can't believe how grown up the children are now!

For Sunday school, we're trying something new! The Gospel Project lessons will no longer be taught on Sundays, but rather in video format and uploaded to our newsletter pages for children and youth each week. The kids are expected to watch them and keep track with the Gospel Project curriculum on a weekly basis until we can safely meet at church to have Sunday school again. We miss all the children and our teacher volunteers as well!

Myanmar Missions

Arise, shine, for your light has come and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.

See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples,

but the LORD rises upon you and his glory appears over you. Isaiah 60:1-2

Hands in Missions, working with EMAS Canada, is one of the few organizations representing the people of Myanmar who have very little. This update will give you clear insights into how we operate and why we need your support and prayer.

Before the Pandemic started in 2020, we ran a couple of Medical Missions in the remote villages of Southern Shan State in Myanmar. We saw over 900 patients come through the clinic in 10 days.

Beside providing medical and dental services, we put emphasis on education. Most of the people are not being taught basic education.





Prayer ministry is the real heart of our ministry. Prayer is the Gateway where people are brought into the Kingdom of God. The offer is there for anyone who wants to hear.

It is good to see a team of medical professionals as well as other volunteers, chipping in, to give some help to disadvantaged people.



COVID-19 related travel restrictions only caused our Myanmar host, Marshall to concentrate all the more on the kingdom building work, living among the locals who are strong Buddhists.

Please pray for the completion of our newest project we have named "Bethel". It sits on a 0.6 acre of land in Southern Shan State. The purpose is to build a base to receive missions teams, and to have a Relive factory, to produce organic Turmeric drink powder, as a mean to draw locals and providing jobs.



Our Oaks of Righteousness project (Isaiah 61:3) in Shan State is on 70 acres of land.

The purpose is to accommodate education centres, workshops, organic farming with livestock to manage ecosystem services, as well as a meeting place for seniors, so as to draw in the locals across all ages, for sustainable practical living across generations.



Our Yuzana Medical Centre clinic in Yangon itself is running on skeleton staffing with dentists working with the utmost precautions, it is running positively even in the current situation.

COVID has caused restrictions to travel and crowd size restrictions, hence both public and private schools alike are all closed, our Yuzana Medical Centre where our ACE students have been lodging, has become both their lodging and study place without interruptions. Since most students could have had problems returning to their parents, as some are even from overseas. Our YMC has been much blessings and being much appreciated by the parents.

We are making a difference and are "Changing Lives, and Giving Hope" across all ages.

In this new year of 2021, I humbly invite you to join me in our short-term medical missions to Myanmar to witness the goodness of God and to encourage and to be the light of Jesus to the underserved people of Myanmar.

May the light of hope and grace encourage your heart. We are grateful for your prayer and financial support.
